Greetings My Fellow Turners,

For those of you with children we offer many different events throughout the year including a Christmas Party which is coming soon along with an Easter Egg hunt and Children's Halloween party. We have games in our clubroom for them to play, a Full playground to use while the weather is good, A Softball Field with games almost nightly during the summer months that you can sit and watch a game with your children and of course all the Gymnastics and Sports programming that you can enroll your children in at a minimal additional cost. These includes gymnastics for all ages of children, floor hockey, Big Shots Basketball, cheerleading camps, t ball, flag football and a host of other programming.

Your membership renewal of \$75.00 helps us to offer all that along with more. For you as an Adult you have a Safe, Clean club that you can bring a group of friends to and have a meal or just a few libations for a night out. We have many TV's located throughout the club to watch a Bears, Hawks Cubs or Sox game throughout the year. Pick a day or night and come out to watch some college Hoops. We are glad to have you here. League Fee is \$550 & games are on Sunday mornings.

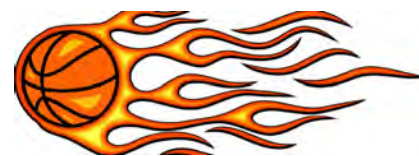
